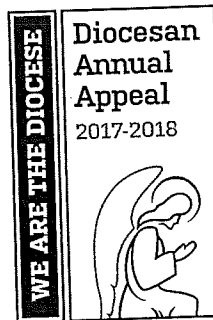

**THE WISCONSIN RAPIDS AREA RETREAT** is being held November 10-12 at St. Anthony Spirituality Center. The theme is "Sacred

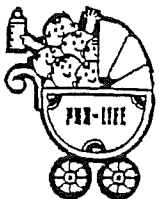
