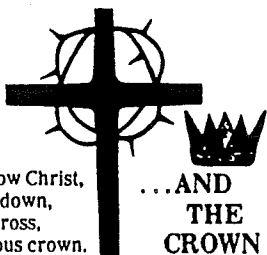

MITE BOXES & RICE BOWLS should be returned on Easter Weekend.

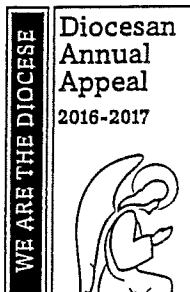
TOWELS for the NCSF collection can be brought to church during Holy Week. Thank you.

EASTER FLOWERS...We are again asking for donations to help pay for decorating our church for Holy Week and Easter. If you can help, please mark your envelope "Flowers."



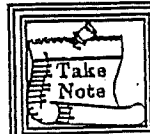
