

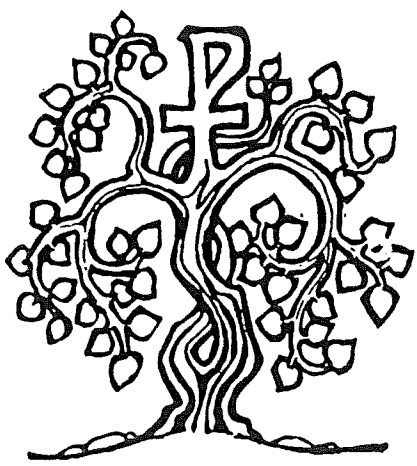

A REMINDER...Those families not able to help with the picnic this year are asked for a \$75 picnic donation.

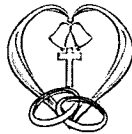
