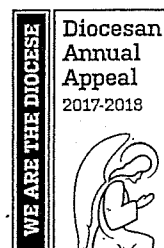
ENTER INTO THE
SEASON OF LENT

THE SEASON OF LENT BEGINS ON ASH WEDNESDAY, FEB. 14.

Lenten regulations are as follows: Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday...only one full meal is allowed and two smaller meals. Eating solid food between meals is not permitted. **Masses on Ash Wednesday are 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Stations of the Cross will be Tuesdays at 6:30 and daily Masses on Wednesday and Friday 8:45.**



Lent

ASH WEDNESDAY, the beginning of Lent is February 14. Masses will be 8:00 a.m. (Father Lynch) and 6:00 p.m. (Father Dave). These weeks of Lent will bring many opportunities to help the less fortunate in our area and to deepen our faith life. **Little Black Books for Lent** are available this weekend, and inserts from Our Sunday Visitor will be provided every week in the bulletin. **Daily Mass** will be celebrated on Wednesdays and Fridays at 8:45 a.m. during Lent.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS, with Deacon Jim Landry, will be held on Tuesdays of Lent at 6:30. Offerings collected will be given to **Catholic Relief Services** who provides relief for the people affected by the many natural disasters in our country.



COMMUNAL PENANCE will be held at St. Philip on Wednesday, March 7, 6:30 p.m. Watch the bulletin for dates and times of services at area churches during Lent.

MITE BOXES will be distributed to **CCD and ACS students, Grades K-8**. This program is an outreach from the Holy Childhood Association, one of the Pontifical Mission Societies represented in the Mission Office. This year, money collected will support Casa Hogar. **RICE BOWLS** will be available for **all other families and high school students** of the parish. This is sponsored by Catholic Relief Services and is organized locally by the Social Concerns Office of the diocese. **Mite Boxes and Rice Bowls should be returned to church on Easter Sunday.**

THE NATIONAL CATHOLIC SOCIETY OF FORESTERS, COURT 998, will hold its Annual Towel Collection during Holy Week, March 26-30. A basket will be in back of church. They will be given to local organizations to be distributed to those in need.

THE NEIGHBORHOOD TABLE, sponsored by our parish, will be held on Tuesday, March 20 at United Methodist Church (behind McMillan Library). Sign-up sheets for workers and desserts will be in the back of church as it gets closer, so please sign up to help when they are available.

THE DEANERY SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE OF WISCONSIN RAPIDS CATHOLIC CHURCHES is sponsoring their Annual Lenten Donation Drive. Our parish will collect adult essential needs (hygiene, personal care and cleaning supplies). Items donated will be given to SWEPS.
