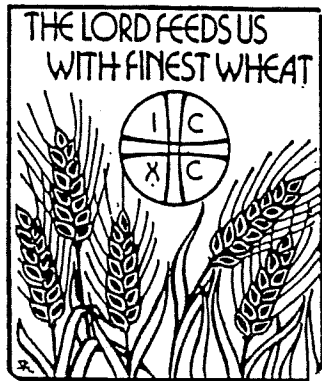

PICNIC SIGNS...It's time get these out of your garage and in your front yard. If you don't have one, pick one up from the vestibule.

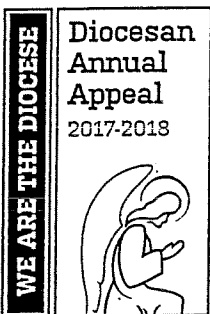
CHRISTMAS STAND...Gently used Christmas items can be dropped off in Wagner Hall.

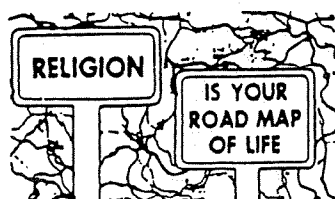
