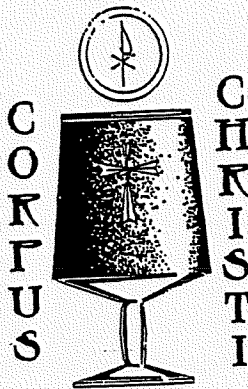

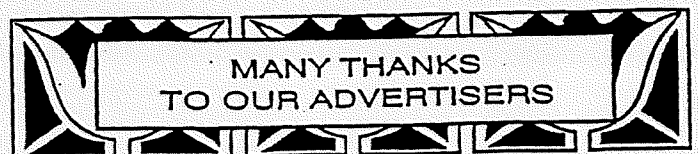


CHRISTMAS STAND...Gently used Christmas items can be dropped off in Wagner Hall.

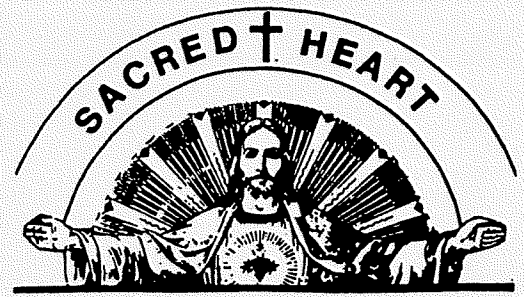
