Lenten Regulations are as follows: Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, And Good Friday. Also, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to **fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday...only one full meal is allowed and two smaller meals. Eating solid food between meals is not permitted. **Masses on Ash Wednesday are 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** See the flier in the bulletin for Lenten activities.

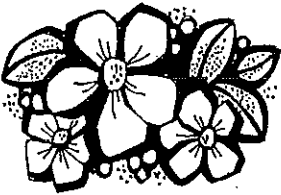
ST. PHILIP PCCW will again be
