Catholics who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. Also, Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, until they celebrate their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday, are to **fast** on Ash

Wednesday and Good Friday...only one full meal is allowed and two smaller meals. Eating solid food between meals is not permitted. **Stations of the Cross & Benediction** will be held on Tuesday, March 12, 6:00 p.m. Offerings will support Sister Salome and the Coffee Plantation in Uganda.

**waiver release form for all who volunteer, in the back of church. We still need more helpers. Please consider helping with this event.**

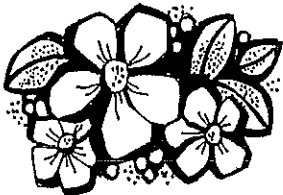
**PICNIC NEWS...**We will again be accepting gently used Christmas items, as well as empty shoe boxes. Please drop off in Wagner Hall.

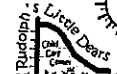
