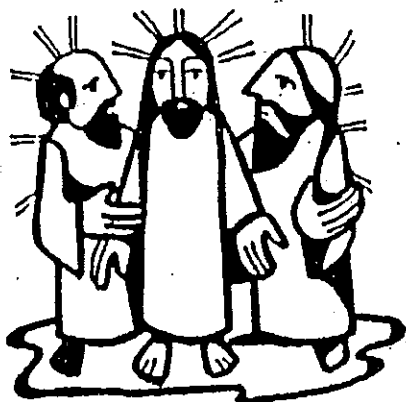

TOWELS, ADULT & INFANT ESSENTIALS are being collected during Lent. Baskets are available in back of church.

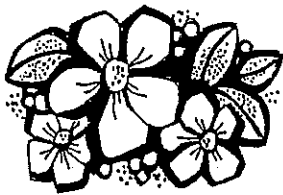
ANNUAL TRIVIA NIGHT
