**DIOCESE OF LACROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE**

The Diocese of LaCrosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reports of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone who wishes to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of LaCrosse, at the Diocese of LaCrosse, P.O. Box 4004, LaCrosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of LaCrosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: [www.dioc.org](http://www.dioc.org).
