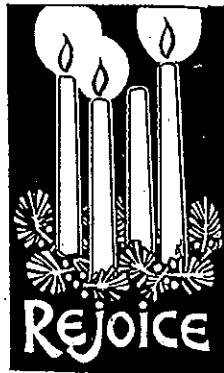

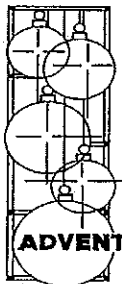
## NEWS
