Also, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday...only one full meal is allowed and two smaller meals. 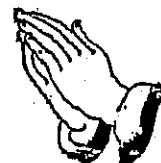
