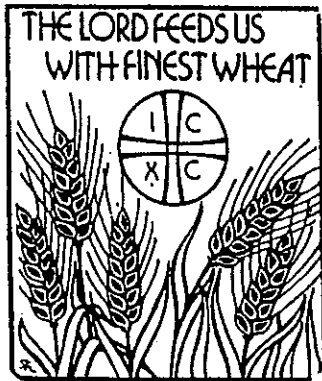

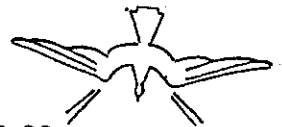


FATHER JANUSZ RETURNS FROM VACATION
