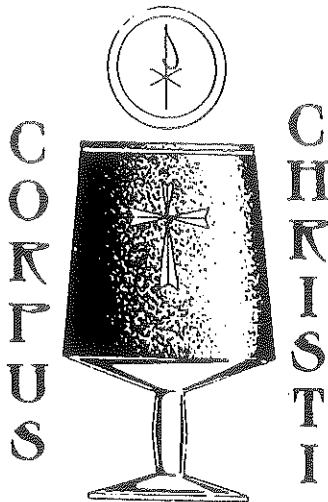

FINANCE REPORT INFO:

In April, St. Philip, St. Lawrence and Assumption Catholic Schools qualified for the Small Business Payroll Protection Program. Under the program, St. Philip received \$6,242.77 which was based on an average payroll cost for 8 weeks. St. Lawrence's payroll costs included Father Janusz's total salary; therefore, St. Philip will not be reimbursing St. Lawrence for St. Philip's share of Father's salary for the 8-week period. ACS advised St. Philip that we do not have to pay any subsidy for 3 months, a savings of \$8,747.58 per month. As a result of this program, our disbursement costs have been reduced for the month of May as reflected in the May Finance Report. Thank you for your prayers and continued financial support of St. Philip Parish. Together we will make it through this difficult time and become a stronger parish.

Project Updates:

- + Cemetery Entrance Project is nearing completion. Thank you to the Arlyn & Lorraine Dorshorst family for donating this as a memorial to their parents.
- + School Memorial Project is being worked on and should be completed in the near future. Money is available to complete this project in the School Memorial Project Savings Account.
- + Church Basement & Bathroom Remodeling Projects...estimates for these projects are being obtained. Proceeds from the NCSF Pancake Breakfast and Gun Raffle, as well as available parish money will be allocated for these projects.
