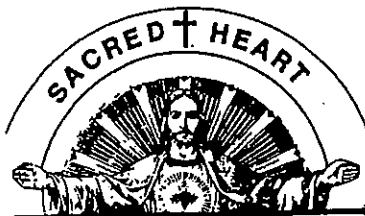

PUBLIC MASSES ARE NOW BEING HELD. FOLLOWING ARE DIRECTIVES THAT NEED TO BE FOLLOWED:

- + The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains dispensed until further notice.
- + Social distancing will be practiced. Signs will be posted on the pews. Ushers will assist to make sure guidelines are followed.
- + All Missals will be removed from the pews. They will be available at the entrance and should be returned following Mass.
- + A basket will be available in the back of church for offertory collection.
- + The Sign of Peace will be omitted.
- + Communicants should observe the 6 foot distance while in line for Holy Communion.
- + Frequently touched surfaces in the church will be cleaned and sanitized after every Mass.
- + Because of airborne issues, we are limiting the singing during Mass.

PLEASE NOTE: From now on, if you are dropping off aluminum cans, please leave them behind the dumpsters on the south side of the church. Thank you.
