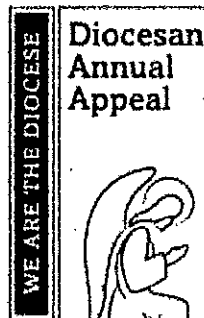

year by making a monetary donation. We still have a way to go to reach our goal of \$20,000. Next year we'll all work together again to celebrate our "100th." God Bless!

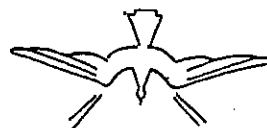

DIOCESAN ANNUAL APPEAL:

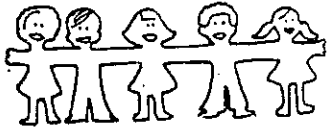

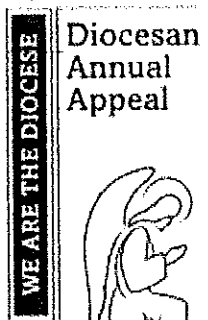
For My Mother
