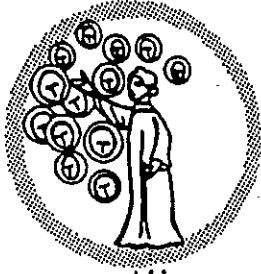
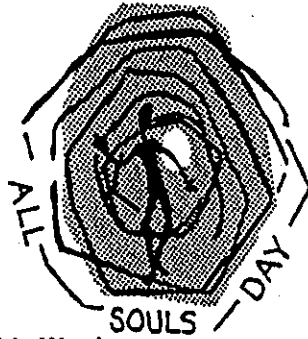

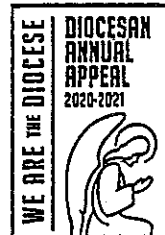

**NOVEMBER 2 IS ALL SOULS DAY.** The Church offers an indulgence for a cemetery visit that is available as a partial indulgence all year round, but from Nov. 1-8, this indulgence is plenary. It

is applicable only to the souls in Purgatory. As a plenary indulgence, it remits all punishment due to sin, which means that simply by performing the requirements of the indulgence, you can obtain the entrance into Heaven of a soul who is currently in Purgatory. To obtain the plenary indulgence, you must receive Communion and sacramental Confession, visit a cemetery and pray for the souls in Purgatory and for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Father Janusz will celebrate Mass on Monday at 4:00 p.m., followed by a procession to All Souls Cemetery, weather permitting. The Rosary with the Sorrowful Mysteries will be prayed.
