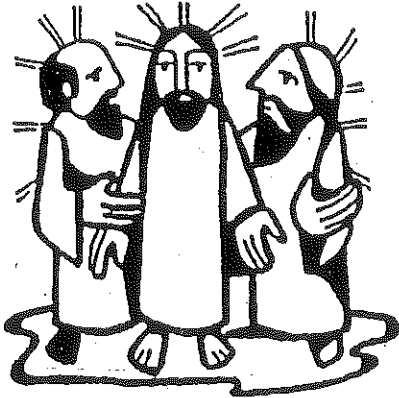

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. Also, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they reach their 59th birthday are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday...only one full meal is allowed and two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held on Sundays at 8:00 a.m. right before 8:30 Mass. Please make the extra effort to attend.

Lenten Aims to CRS Rice Bowl support Catholic Relief Services work in more than 100 countries. Please be generous!!

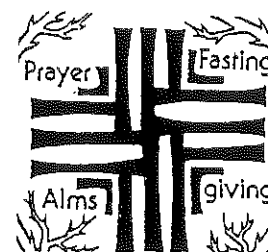
