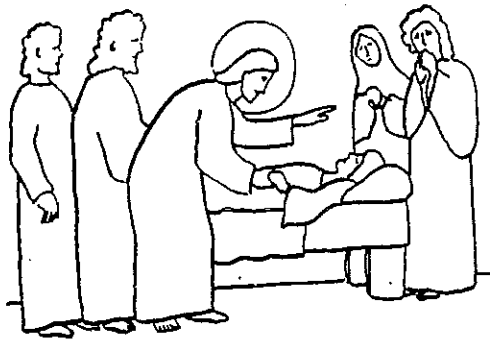

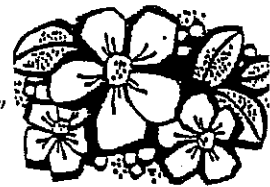


**OUR 100TH PICNIC IS
