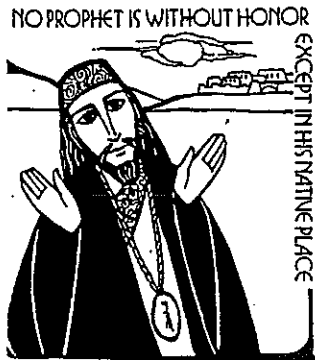

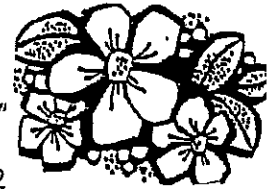


OUR 100TH PICNIC IS AUGUST 1 !! There will be some changes this year but we are working to make it a great picnic. The work

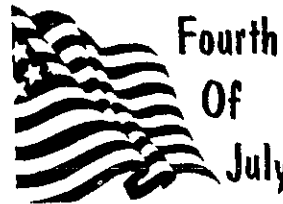
