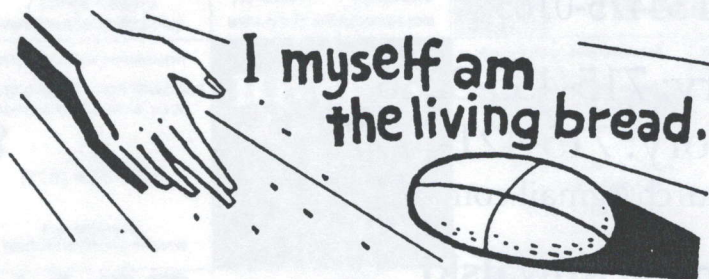


IN OUR PARISH
