a Plenary Indulgence from November 1-8. This indulgence remits all punishment due to sin, which means that simply by performing the requirements, you can obtain the entrance into Heaven of a soul who is currently in Purgatory. To obtain the indulgence, you must receive Communion and sacramental Confession, visit a cemetery and pray for the souls in Purgatory and the intentions of the Holy Father. Father Janusz will offer Mass on All Saints Day, Monday, November 1 at 4:00 p.m. followed by a procession to All Souls Cemetery and the Rosary.
