LENTE REGULATIONS: Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound by this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held on Fridays of Lent at 6:00 p.m. Monetary offerings will be given to Casa Hogar in Peru. This Friday, March 4, Stations will be followed by Adoration, Benediction and Confession from 6:30-7:30. **Make this part of your Lenten journey.**
