## **LENTEN REGULATIONS:**

Catholics who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition, Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, until they celebrate their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound by this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.


