LENTEN REGULATIONS:

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition, Catholics who have

celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound by this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

DURING THIS LENTEN SEASON OF PRAYER, FASTING AND ALMS, make that extra effort to:

Attend Daily Mass on Wednesday and Friday.

Stations of the Cross are Fridays at 6:00. Monetary offerings will be given to Casa Hogar.
