LENTEN REGULATIONS:

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to **abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.** In addition, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until their 59th birthday, **are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** Those who are bound by this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to main strength, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held on Tuesdays of Lent at 6:00 p.m. Monetary donations will be used for Ukraine relief.

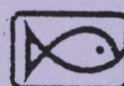
