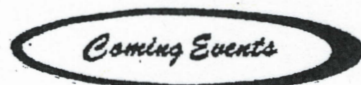

BINGO IS BACK AT ASSUMPTION...Doors open at noon with games starting at 1:00. Cash only. Next date is Sunday, October 1.



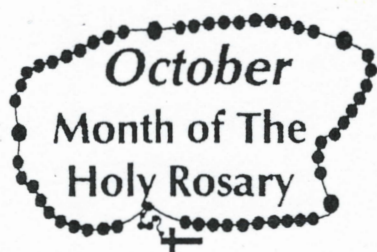
