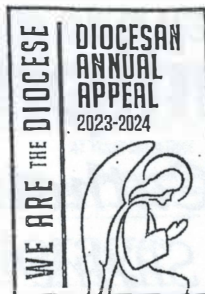

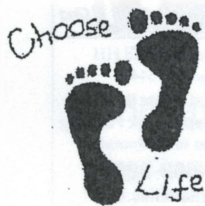
SEEKING ALL CATHOLIC 4 & 5 YEAR OLDS! Please
