

ASH WEDNESDAY, February 14, marks the beginning of Lent. Please read the insert in today's bulletin with information of what is happening here at St. Philip. There will be Mass at 8:45 and a Prayer Service with ashes at 6:30.

LENTEN REGULATIONS:

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

In addition from abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
