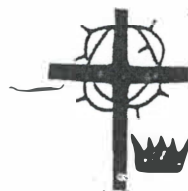

THE DIVINE MERCY PAINTING now hanging in our church was painted in 1956 by Sister Mary Luciana Kolasinski. Sister (1896-1966), a member of the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Third Order of St. Francis, lived at St. Joseph Convent in Stevens Point. In addition to the Divine Mercy painting, the oil paintings of "The Five Wise Virgins" and "Graduate – Lord What Will Thou Have Me Do?" are hanging in the Welcome Center. They had previously been housed at St. Joseph Convent until the Convent and the grounds were sold in 2021 to a developer. They were donated to St. Philip by Tim & Pam Jensen. Sister was a gifted artist having 11 oil paintings copyrighted and registered with the Library of Congress. We are so blessed to have these beautiful oil paintings displayed in our parish.
