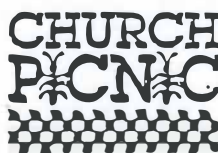

Put your name on the small games donations so you can be entered in a drawing for a gift card.

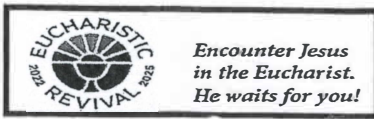
