**A REMINDER** that those families not able to work for the picnic are asked for a \$100 picnic donation. Thank you.

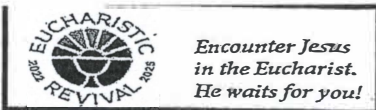

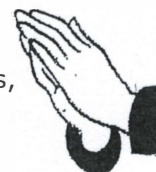
