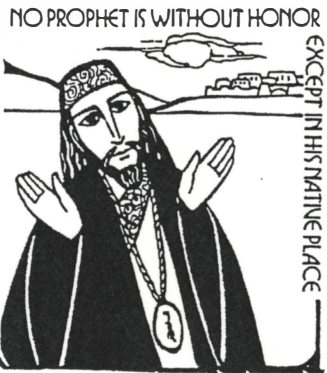

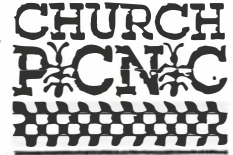

MASS STIPENDS...The suggested stipend for Masses has remained the same for over 30 years in the dioceses in

Wisconsin. Recently, the Bishops of the state decreed that the rate should be adjusted, reasons being that the stipend is intended to cover a priest's daily meal/living expense. Effective July 1, the stipend will be \$20. All Masses currently scheduled are exempt from this increase.
