GREETINGS WISCONSIN RAPIDS DEANERY...On behalf of ACS, I want to express our gratitude for the support of time, talent, and treasure you provide. All three aspects of stewardship are important. The 2024-25 school year is

underway. In addition to being a year of academics and formation in the faith, it is also an anniversary year. In the fall of 1954, the building currently occupied by ACM/ACS opened to the students who had been the previous three years using space at OLQH. Those first students graduated in the spring of 1955. Therefore, this year marks the 70th graduating class. In addition, 1999 and 2009 mark dates in the creation of the system we have today as the schools consolidated and we became a system that spans ages 6 weeks to 12th grade. We honor the legacy of the former parish schools, both those whose buildings we use – St. Lawrence, OLQH, and St. Vincent, and those whose buildings have receded into history – Sacred Heart, SS Peter & Paul, and St. Philip. During this 70th anniversary year, we are asking all of our supporters to consider an extra gift to continue to build ACS into a bastion of faithful Catholic education. Beyond your normal gift could you consider an extra gift of \$100, \$500 or even more? If 1000 people each gave an average of \$700, we would have an additional fund of \$700,000 for improvements and long-term sustainability of the schools.
