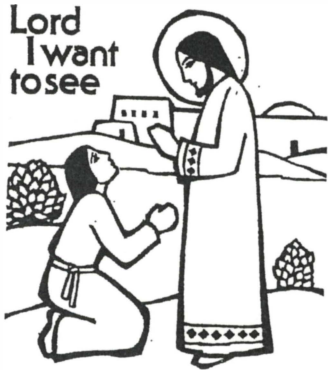

**PLENARY INDULGENCE:
VISIT A CEMETERY
AND PRAY FOR THE DEAD**

Release a soul from Purgatory each day
November 1-8.

The Church offers an Indulgence for a cemetery visit that is available as a Partial Indulgence all year round, and a Plenary Indulgence from November 1-8. It is applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, remitting all punishment due to sin, which means that simply by performing the requirements of the Indulgence, you can obtain the entrance into Heaven of a soul who is currently in Purgatory.

To obtain the Indulgence one must receive Holy Communion and sacramental Confession, visit a cemetery and pray for the souls in Purgatory and for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Father Janusz will celebrate Mass at St. Lawrence on Friday, November 1 at 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., and at 8:45 a.m. at St. Philip's.
