In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday...eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
