

He currently serves as the director of intellectual formation at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee. He is one of the National Eucharistic Preachers and has preached about the Eucharist in various states. He has studied philosophy, theology and bioethics. He taught high school and lay formation, undergraduates from Christendom College, master students at St. Paul seminary and seminarians at the Gregorian University in Rome and now as adjunct professor at Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology.
