Mission Appeal - 2025 for the Diocese of Vellore, India

Greetings from Fr. Nathan of the Catholic Diocese of Vellore, India. The Diocese of Vellore was established by the Salesians in 1952. It comprises 87 parishes organized into eight deaneries, serving a Catholic population of 1,78,980.

After serving joyfully for ten years in the Diocese of La Crosse, I am preparing to return permanently to my home Diocese on July 1 due to health reasons. During the weekend of the 21st and 22nd, I will visit our parishes as a missionary for my home Diocese. On behalf of Bishop Ambrose, I invite each of you to pray for my home Diocese and to consider supporting us financially to continue all our pastoral and educational activities.

Due to the financial crisis, we have scaled back some of our activities. Our political leaders are corrupt and focus solely on Hindus, doing nothing for rural residents, especially Christians. My Diocese is rural, consisting of many villages, and most of the people living there are below the poverty line. We Christians do not receive equal respect in the country; the ruling Hindu government treats us as second-class citizens. Yet, despite our difficulties, we continue our basic pastoral and educational efforts aimed at improving the situation for the most deserving, and your generous financial support can be a great encouragement.

Ten Major Pastoral and Educational Ministries:

- Sponsorship program for orphaned and semi-orphaned children.
- After-school programs and tutoring centers in rural parishes.
- Income Generation Program for widows and widowers.
- Vocational Training for drop-out students (Trades: fitter, welding, electrician, carpentry, motor mechanics, and driving).
- Job training programs for youth (IAS, IPS, and TNPSC).
- Computer Education Program for rural children.
- Medical camps for the sick and elderly.
- Solar Panel Electricity Program for SC/ST communities.
- Deanery-level vacation camps for young adults.
- Health care programs for pregnant mothers.
