

that Father Guanella (OLQH), Father Weller (OLQH & Assumption Chaplain), and Father Williams (SS Peter & Paul) would be transferred to new assignments on July 1: Father Guanella to LaCrosse as Judicial Vicar, Father Weller to LaCrosse as Vocations Director, and Father Williams to Stevens Point as associate pastor at St. Joseph/Stephen & Pacelli Chaplain. A few weeks ago it was announced that Father Nathan (Pittsville, Vesper & Sigel) was returning to India because of poor health. Their new pastor will be announced soon and arrive mid-July. A week ago we learned that our Father Janusz will be transferred on August 12 to St. Therese in Schofield an St. Mark in Rothschild.
