

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: This week the children are invited to reflect on what would happen if one of the branches contained a block to the sap which fills it with life. What sort of fruit would be borne? Would it be as beautiful? Because the branches are so interconnected would the block in one branch affect the other branches as well? In this pondering we lift up John 15:7 where Jesus invites us to "ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you?" 
