RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:

The children have been spending time with the Easter announcement – the proclamation that Jesus, who died, is now alive. Even our youngest children respond with awe and great joy as they hear the words proclaimed: "Christ has died, but He is risen!" We ponder how the light of the risen Christ continues to shine in the world today. You may see your child quietly contemplating this mystery, wanting to relight candles or noticing the beauty of the white cloth on the prayer table. Their joy often shows up in simple, beautiful ways. Ways to nurture this joy at home during the Easter season:

- *Light a candle during prayer time and say together "Jesus is the Light of the World."
- *Invite your child to notice where they see signs of "new life" in nature or daily life.
- *Create a prayer card with the word: Alleluia. We sing or say "Alleluia" when we want to praise the Lord.
- *Place fresh flowers in your prayer corner each week.
