**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:** As we approach the end of the Atrium year, we prepare to celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. While Christmas and Easter are certainly worthy of great emphasis, where does Pentecost fit? Holy Week includes some of the most important moments of salvation history. We celebrate the gift of Easter for 7 weeks and mark the end of our celebrations with Pentecost, just as Jesus did! Jesus said, "It is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you." (John 16:7). 40 days after his Resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven. 10 days later the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles, marking the fulfillment of Christ's promise and the birth of the Church. At our last class together, May 13, we gather in the church to reflect on the Pentecost Scriptures and review the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit. Each student will choose one gift they ask to be stirred up within them; Understanding, Knowledge, Wisdom, Fortitude, Counsel, Piety, Fear of the Lord (Awe & Wonder). Even the 3 year old child knows they want the Holy Spirit to work in them - so beautiful!

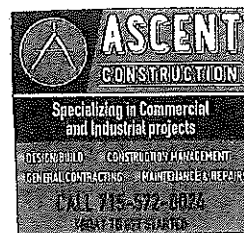
