THE FALL LADIES' CCW DEANERY MEETING

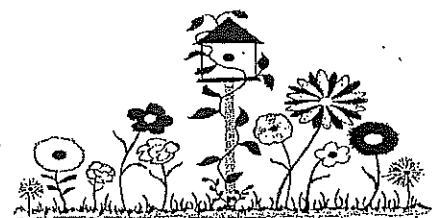
