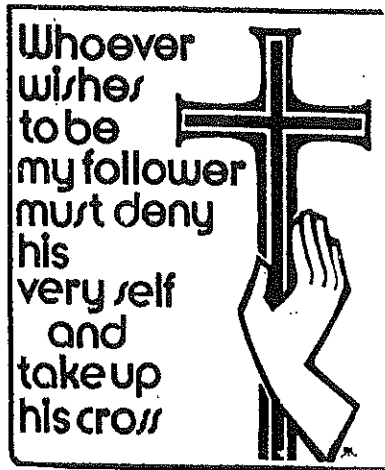

WHAT IS SCRIP???

Welcome back to school and welcome to the Assumption Scrip Program!! For those of you who do not know, the Scrip Program enables families to easily reduce their tuition and help fund school operations for ACS. Essentially, Scrip is another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards. For example, if a \$100 Kwik Trip gift card is purchased and the rebate is 10%, that means the card is purchased for \$90 by the school and you purchase the card for \$100. The remaining \$10 is split: 70% back to our families and 30% back to ACS for operations.

There are several ways and places that Scrip can be purchased:

1. Walk in purchases are available at the main Scrip Office which is located in the AHS building at the corner of Hill and Mead Streets (Northwest corner of the building). Walk in purchases are also available at St. Vincent School and Our Lady School in the front office. In addition, each parish has Scrip available after mass and sometimes in the Parish Rectory. Each Parish is different, please check with your Parish for their Scrip options.
2. Scrip can also be purchased online through www.raiseright.com. You will be prompted for an enrollment code which I will not include here for security reasons however please email or call the Scrip Office for the code: terra.duellman@acswr.org, or call 715-422-0909. Online orders can be paid by check sent to the Scrip Office, direct ACH withdrawal, or credit card. RaiseRight explains payment options and how to set up payment on their website.
3. RaiseRight has also added a mobile app which allows electronic transactions in the event you'd prefer not to carry plastic cards. Again, www.raiseright.com will walk through everything needed to know to use the app.

Scrip was created at ACS to assist with family tuition however there are a few other options if you no longer have a student at ACS:

1. Your student that attends ACS
2. Any student you designate that is in financial need that attends ACS
3. A Parish in our area
4. Guardian Angel—funds distributed to students in need
5. Staff—Any designated ACS staff member who then uses funds for classroom materials.

Most people begin using Scrip for everyday items such as gas and groceries. The Scrip order form attached to this email include the cards available for purchase in the Scrip Office. Please talk to Terra Duellman for ordering options for additional vendors and denominations that are offered through Raise Right. Scrip Office hours during the school year are:

Monday 9-noon

Tuesday 9-1

Thursday 11-6

Lastly, the Scrip Office runs on volunteers. We have a skeleton crew of faithful volunteers of which I am very grateful. We do our best to cover each other however, new volunteers are always welcome. Please feel free to contact me if you're interested in volunteering!!
